AMBULANCE SERVICE EMPLOYEES' AWARD - STATE 2003

(Gazette, 30 January 2004)

PURSUANT to the Declaration of the Commission as to a General Ruling made on 7 August 2008, the said Award is amended as follows as from 1 September 2008:

1. By deleting clause 5.2.1 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

5.2.1 The minimum rates payable to the following class of Employees under this Award shall be:

The rates of pay in clause 5.2 comprise the minimum rates payable under this Award.

The rates incorporate adjustments based upon the Queensland Ambulance Service Enterprise Partnership Agreement 1999 (CA340 of 1999) and the AFCOM Enterprise Partnership Certified Agreement 2000 (CA604 of 2000).

2. By deleting clauses 5.2.4 and 5.2.5 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

5.2.4 The rates of pay in this Award are intended to include the arbitrated wage adjustment payable under the 1 September 2008 Declaration of General Ruling and earlier Safety Net Adjustments and arbitrated wage adjustments. [Disputed cases are to be referred to the Vice President.] This arbitrated wage adjustment may be offset against any equivalent amount in rates of pay received by employees whose wages and conditions of employment are regulated by this Award which are above the wage rates prescribed in the Award. Such

payments include wages payable pursuant to certified agreements, currently operating enterprise flexibility agreements, Queensland workplace agreements, award amendments to give effect to enterprise agreements and overaward arrangements. Absorption which is contrary to the terms of an agreement is not required.

5.2.5 Increases made under previous State Wage Cases or under the current Statement of Policy, excepting those resulting from enterprise agreements, are not to be used to offset arbitrated wage adjustments.

3. By deleting from the clauses listed in the first column of the Schedule, the amount in the second column, and inserting the amount in the third column in lieu thereof:
