Reasons for Decision

[1] On 27 November 2020, the Somerset Regional Council applied pursuant, to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* ("the Act"), to terminate the *Somerset Regional Council Certified Agreement 2015* ("the certified agreement").

- [2] The certified agreement has a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2017.
- [3] The application was filed in the Industrial Registry, together with an affidavit in support of Mr Andrew Johnson, Chief Executive Officer of the Somerset Regional Council, and a Notice of Intention to terminate a Certified Agreement.
- [4] Having regard to the material relied upon in support of the application, I am satisfied that:
 - (a) the certified agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need be met before it may be terminated; ¹
 - (b) the Council has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the certified agreement;²
 - (c) all parties to the certified agreement agree to it being terminated;³ and
 - (d) the termination of the certified agreement is not contrary to the public interest.⁴
- [5] Section 228(4) of the Act provides that termination takes effect when the Commission's approval takes effect.

- [6] In this matter, an application was made by the Somerset Regional Council and the Queensland Services, Industrial Union of Employees to certify the *Somerset Regional Council Officers Certified Agreement 2020.*⁵
- [7] Accordingly, I approve the termination of the certified agreement with effect form 22 January 2021.
- [8] I make the following order:
 - 1. The Somerset Regional Council Certified Agreement 2015 is terminated.
