Reasons for Decision

- On 16 October 2023, the Office of the State of Queensland (Department of Energy and Public Works) ('the Department') applied, pursuant to s 228(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld) ('the IR Act'), to terminate the *QBuild Office Staff Certified Agreement 2019* ('the certified agreement').
- [2] The certified agreement has a nominal expiry date of 31 August 2023.
- [3] The application was filed in the Industrial Registry, together with an affidavit in support of Ms Amanda Michelle Edie, Chief Human Resources Officer, Department of Energy and Public Works, and a Notice of intention to terminate a certified agreement.
- [4] Having regard to the material relied upon in support of the application, I am satisfied that:
 - (a) the certified agreement does not include any provisions recording that any particular conditions need be met before it may be terminated;¹
 - (b) the Department has given notice of its intention to apply to terminate the certified agreement;²
 - (c) all parties to the certified agreement agree to it being terminated;³ and
 - (d) the termination of the certified agreement is not contrary to the public interest.⁴
- I have also had regard to an application having been made to certify the *State Government Entities Certified Agreement 2023* which is proposed to cover employees currently engaged under the *QBuild Office Staff Certified Agreement 2019*.⁵
- [6] Section 228(4) of the IR Act provides that termination takes effect when the Commission's approval takes effect. I approve the termination of the certified agreement with effect from 23 October 2023.
