## **Reasons for Decision**

- [1] A referral to vary the *Brisbane City Council Operational and Trade Employees Award State 2016* (the Award) by the making of a Determination varying the Award in accordance with sections 140GA(2)(a) and 140GC(2)(b)(i) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999* (the Act) was provided by Deputy President Bloomfield, as head of the Commission's Award Modernisation Project, for the following purposes:
  - (i) to create a minimum safety net of employment conditions, in keeping with the modern award objectives at section 140D of the Act, that is fair and relevant in accordance with sections 140G(2)(a) and 140D of the Act; and
  - (ii) to remove ambiguity and uncertainty and/or correct an error, in accordance with section 140GC(1) of the Act.
- [2] The referral for the making of a Determination to vary the Modern Award is supported by Brisbane City Council, Automotive, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred

Industries Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland, Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland, Electrical Trades Union of Employees Queensland, Plumbers and Gasfitters Employees Union of Queensland, Union of Employees, The Australian Workers' Union of Employees, Queensland, Transport Workers' Union of Australia, Union of Employees (Queensland Branch) and United Voice, Industrial Union of Employees, Queensland.

- [4] In the circumstances, the Full Bench is satisfied that it is appropriate for the Determination to be approved.
